ACTS 8

"The Spirit in Action"

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain (abide) in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

~ John 15:5

Acts 8 – Text in Context

Takes place after Stephen's stoning

• 8:1 – "And Saul approved of their killing him."

Church being persecuted

 8:3 – "But Saul began to destroy the church. Going from house to house, he dragged off both men and women and put them in prison."

Scattered/Empowered

Acts 8:1 – "and all except the apostles were scattered throughout Judea and Samaria"

- Opposite of the togetherness earlier in Acts (2:1; 2:44; 4:32)
- Fulfills Acts 1:8 "and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Juda and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Scattered/Empowered

⁴ Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went. ⁵ Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Messiah there. ~Acts 8:4,5

 Preached - Εὐαγγελιζόμενοι - "Brought the Good News"

Directs/Connects

- Vs. 26 "Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, "Go south to the road—the desert road—that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza."
- Vs. 29 The Spirit told Philip, "Go to that chariot and stay near it."

Direct/ Connect

Vs. 30 – "Then Philip ran up to the chariot."

- Phillip responded because he was connected to the Spirit and was eager to connect with the Eunuch.
- "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit." ~Galatians 5:25

How can we like Philip, know when the Spirit is speaking to us?

Inviting/Igniting

Vs. 31 "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked. ³¹ "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.

Vs. 35 - "Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus."

• (NASB) – "Then Philip opened his mouth"

Inviting/Igniting

Vs. 36 – "What can stand in the way of me being baptized?"

- When the Spirit moves and there is obedience to the Spirit – the Bible tells us that there will be belief/repentance/baptism/ and spirit-filing
- Vs. 39 The Eunuch went on his way rejoicing.

- Are we allowing the Spirit to speak to us as believers?
- What gifts of the Spirit has God grown in me for the edification of others?
- What things are keeping me from embracing the power of the Holy Spirit in my life?
