What is the Word of God?

Word of God: The revelation of God to mankind.

"By revelation we mean the whole self-disclosure of God to man, whatever forms that disclosure may assume." Harold S. Bender. *Biblical Revelation and Inspiration*.

"The Word of God is the incarnation of the thought of God." Daniel Kaufmann. *Bible Doctrine*.

What is the Word of God?

The Word of God has come to us in several forms throughout the Bible:

- 1. The messages God communicated to His people through His prophets.
- 2. The proclaimed message of the Gospel.
- 3. The written Scriptures of the Old Covenant.
- 4. The personal Word of God, Jesus.

The Word of God: The Prophets

¹In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, **Heb. 1:1**

¹After this, the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision... Gen. 1:1

¹ The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions. **1 Sam 3:1**



LEARN THE WORD.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 | *The "Shema"*

⁴ Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ⁵ Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. ⁶ These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. ⁷ Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. ⁸ Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. ⁹ Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

Psalm 1 | The Blessed Man
¹ Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers,

Psalm 1 | The Blessed Man ² but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. ³ That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither whatever they do prospers.
