PA state law says that Junior & Senior High age students are legally allowed to be responsible for taking their own medication. Therefore, Franconia Mennonite sponsors or leaders will not dispense or carry youth's meds. As such JR & SR high youth are responsible to provide and carry their own prescription medications. Elementary aged children may have their prescription medications carried & dispensed by Franconia Mennonite Sponsors when complete written instructions for carrying & dispensing are provided & medications are in the original container from the pharmacist. Over the counter first aid & medicine will be available unless a written request stating otherwise is provided by parents.

Permissions and waivers – Parents, please read and understand each of the below paragraphs before signing this form. See Kyle Rodgers, Pastor of Outreach and Youth Ministries, with any questions.

All youth are expected to conform to this code of conduct during any church related event or activity:

- No possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco
- No fighting, weapons, fireworks, lighters, or explosives
- No offensive or immodest clothing (modest one piece swim suits or tankinis showing no midriff are required for any MYF beach/swimming events)
- No boys in girls' sleeping quarters and no girls in boys' sleeping quarters
- Participation and compliance with the group schedule and adult authority is expected
- Respect for property, one another, staff, and adult leaders

*Youth who fail to comply with these expectations may be sent home at their parents' expense.

Medical – I, the undersigned legal parent/guardian, give my permission for youth group adult leaders to transport my child to or from a doctor/hospital/medical facility for medical treatment as needed. I give permission for medical personnel to perform emergency treatment and inject or administer drugs in conjunction with medical care. I understand that if my child needs emergency treatment, I will be contacted. However, if I cannot be reached, I give permission for treatment to be secured as the youth leaders deem best.

Transport – I understand that my child may be transported in various vehicles/buses/planes/trains as part of youth group activities and trips, and I give standing permission for this transport.

Publicity – I understand that my child's image will be captured by photo/video/similar during youth group events. I give permission for images/recordings of and writing by my child to be used in newsletters, emails, website, pamphlets, social media, and similar forms of communication/publicity.

Liability – In consideration of being allowed to participant in any event sponsored by Franconia Mennonite Church, and any related events and activities, and intending to be legally bound, the undersigned:

1. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that may involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence, but the action, inaction or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
2. Assume all the foregoing risk and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
3. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue Franconia Mennonite Church their respective administrators, members, agents, and other employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releases", from any and all liability to each of the undersigned, his or her heirs and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.

I/WE HAVE READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE, UNDERSTAND THAT WE HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY.
