

Revelation 2:8-11

To the angel of the church in Smyrna write:

These are the words of him who is the First and the Last, who died and came to life again. I know your afflictions and your poverty—yet you are rich! I know about the slander of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. I tell you, the devil will put some of you in prison to test you, and you will suffer persecution for ten days. Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you life as your victor's crown.

Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. The one who is victorious will not be hurt at all by the second death.

For further reflection

Think back to a time when you endured hardship or suffering. What gave you strength in that situation? What is your perspective on that experience now?

Why do you think this particular letter begins with a reminder about the death and resurrection of Jesus?

In v10, suffering is described as a form of testing. What does suffering test in us? What does suffering reveal about us?

In v11, Jesus says, "Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches." How would you assess your ability to "listen" spiritually? Is there anything that gets in the way of you hearing what the Spirit may be saying?
