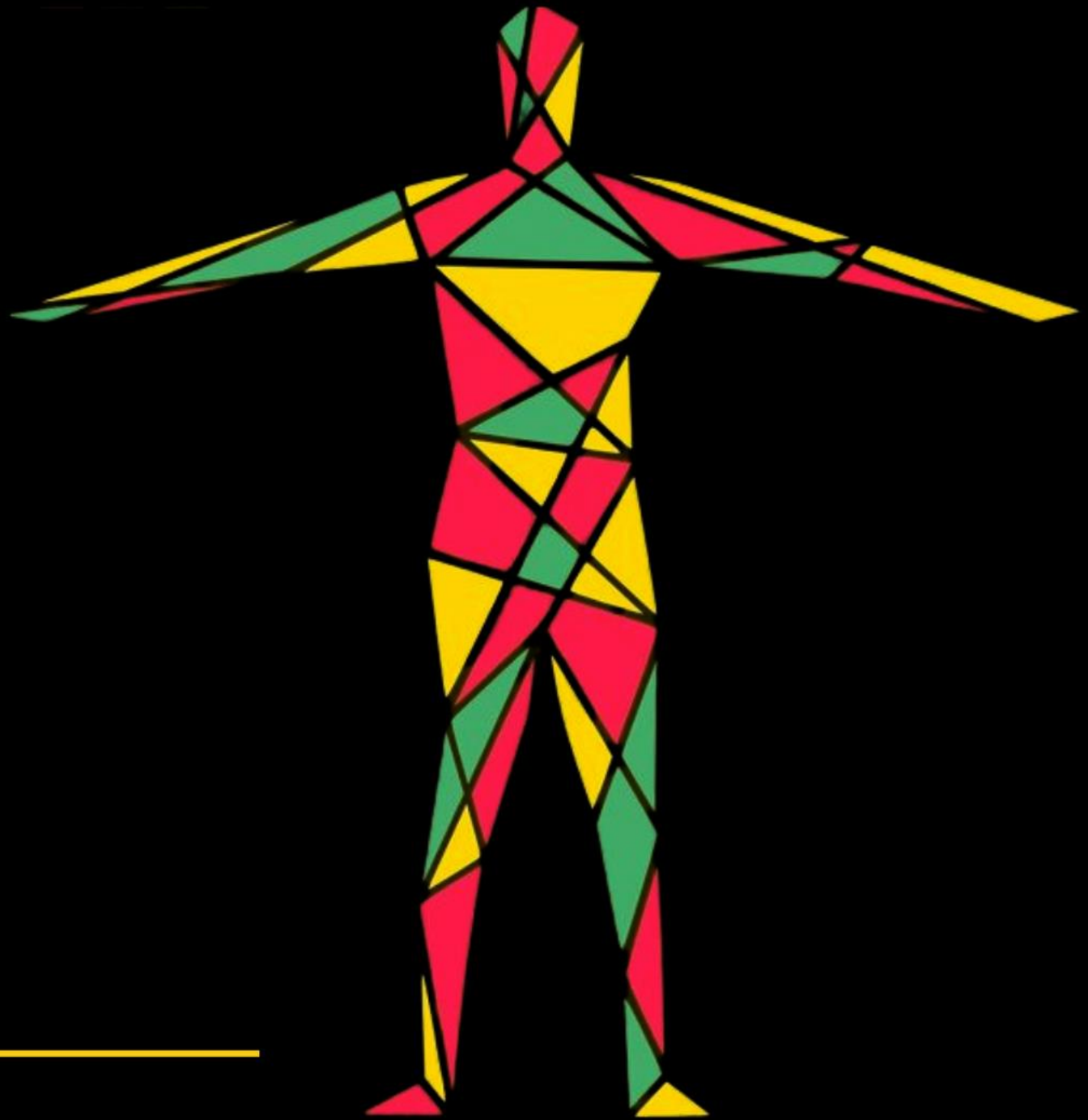

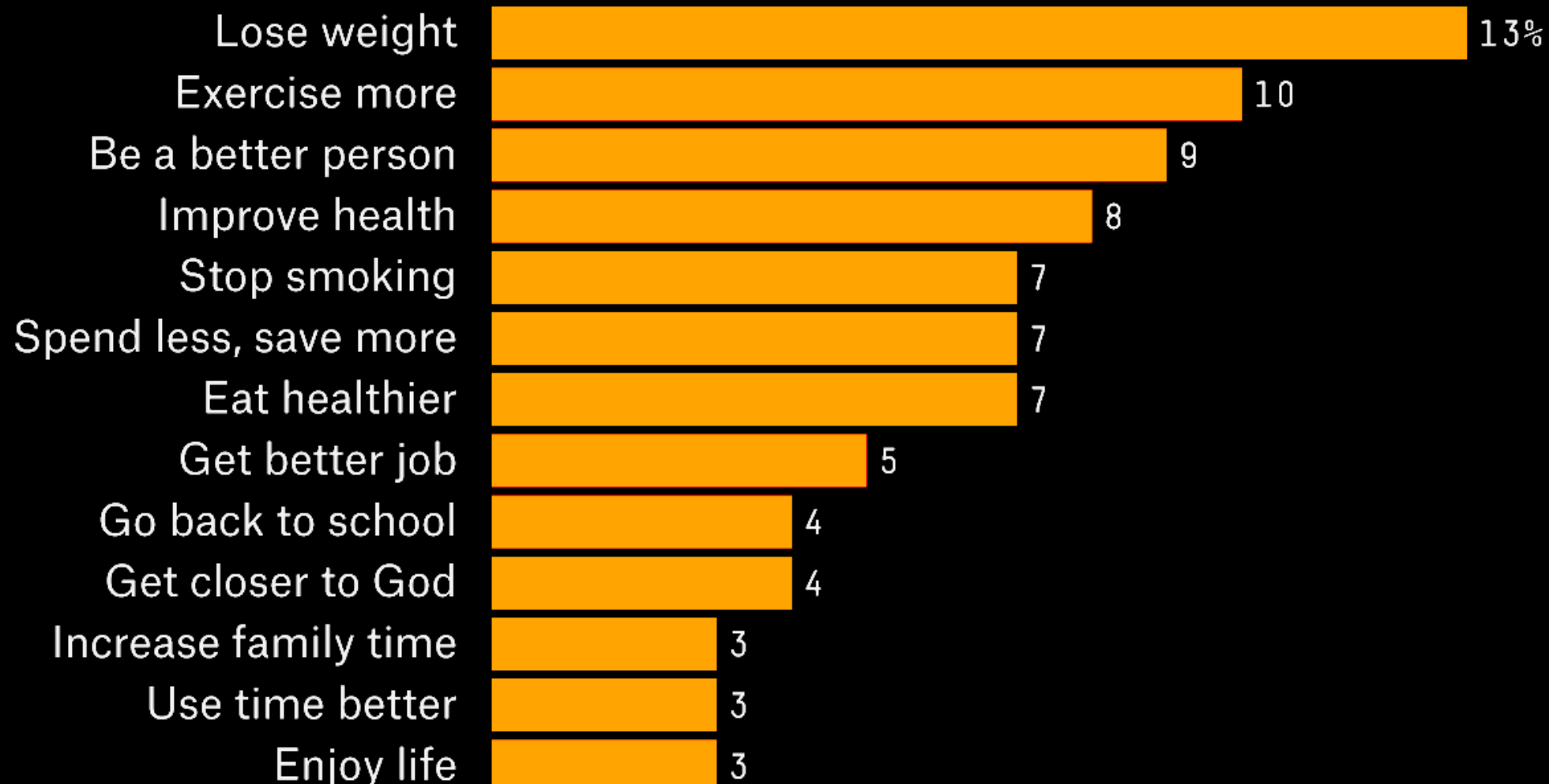

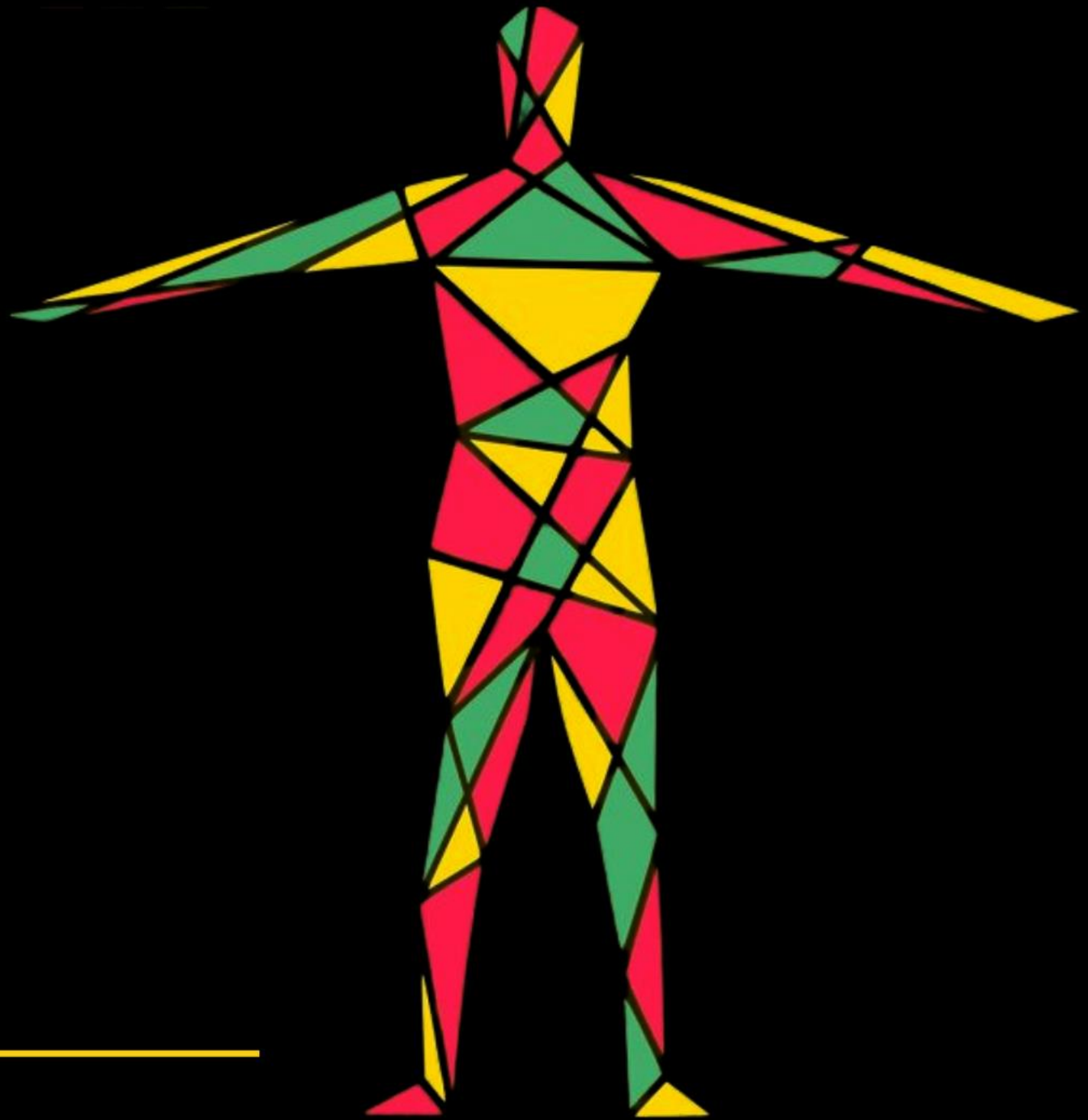

- We share the goodness and abundance of God's riches through stewardship of our time, spiritual gifts, tithes and offerings— to further God's work in our congregation and bless others.

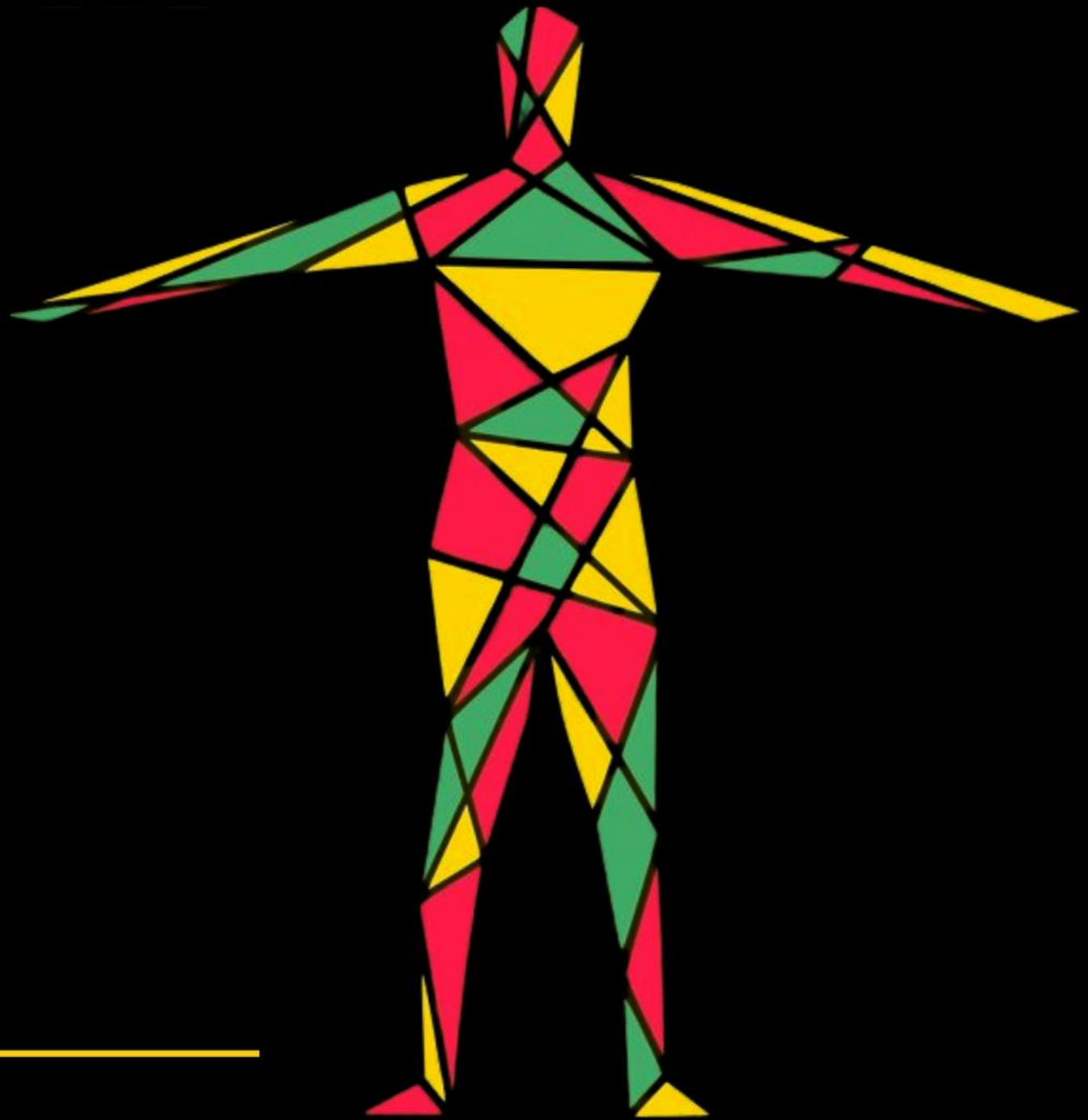
We commit ourselves to a life of love.
