Our "Eternity-Blind" Age

Temporary mindsets; "eternity-blind"—a form of spiritual shortsightedness that perceives the "here and now" in the following ways:

I. This age matters more than eternity.
 II. The present age is simply all there is.

Genesis 1:1-2

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

Exodus 3:14 ¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.'"

Psalm 90:2 ² Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Isaiah 40:28 ²⁸ Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth.

Temporary mindsets:

I. This age matters more than eternity. II. The present age is simply all there is. Prioritizing the temporary shifts our worldview from God-centered to man-centered. > Are my thoughts, words, and actions generally focused on temporary or eternal things?

Do my thoughts, words, and actions more often serve to reflect,

the eternal nature of God

or

the temporary nature of this present age?

Things are not always as they first appear:

1. The woman's change of wardrobe. T or E? The temporary served/revealed the eternal.

2. The man's newfound church work. *T or E? The eternal served/revealed the temporary.*

Ephesians 5:24-27

Temporary mindsets; "eternity-blind"—sees the present age as more important than eternity and/or simply all there is. Prognosis: If treated, permanently curable. If left untreated, eternally fatal. Treatment: Col. 3:1-2; Eph. 5:26; 2 Tim 2:22; Gal. 5:16; 2 Cor. 5:7; Rm. 10:13
