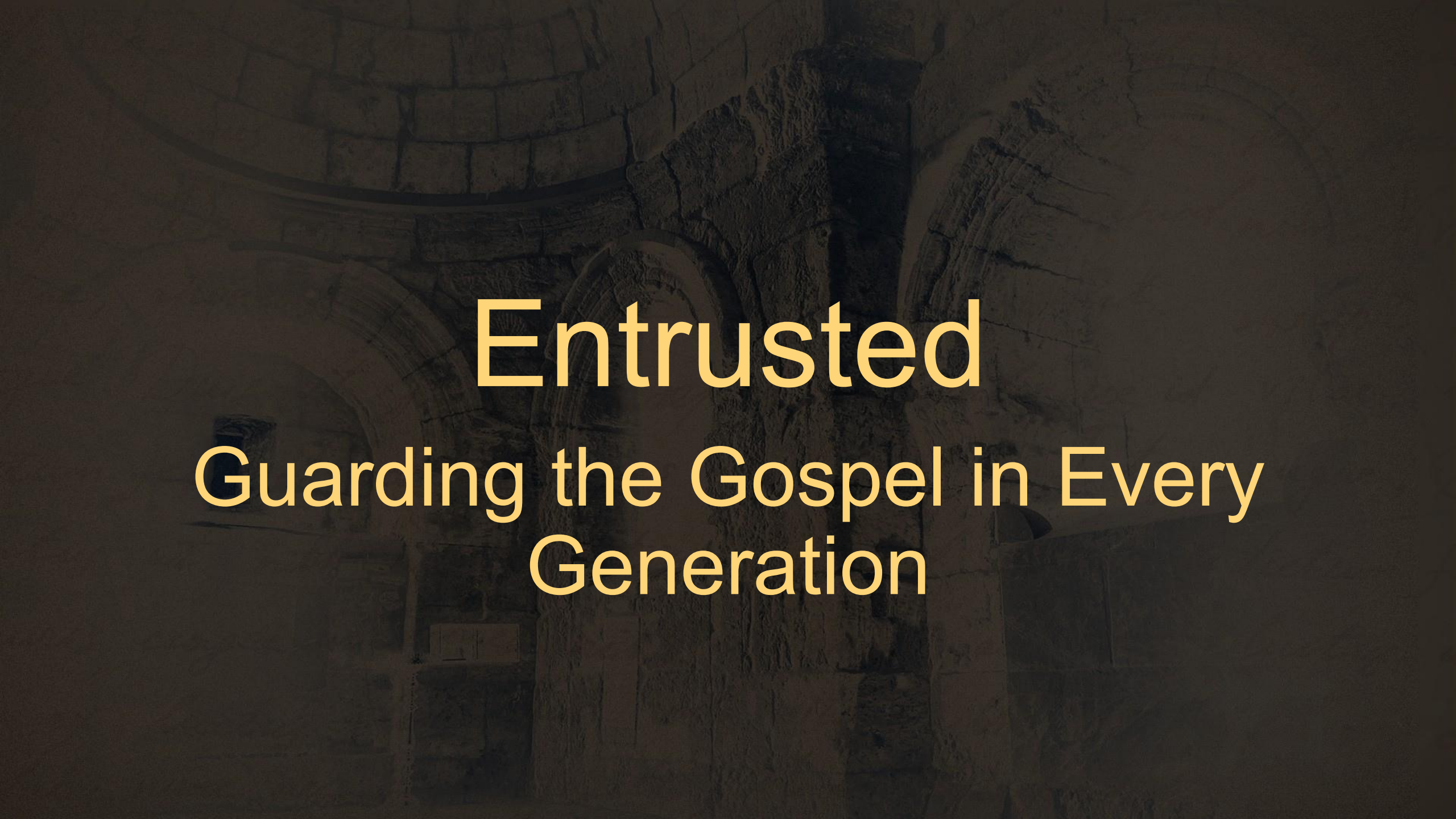

The Power of the Gospel to Save Sinners

1 Tim 1:9-10

“We also know that the law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious, for those who kill their fathers or mothers, for murderers, for the sexually immoral, for those practicing homosexuality, for slave traders and liars and perjurers—and for whatever else is contrary to the sound doctrine.”

1 Tim 1:12

1 Tim 1:13-14

“Even though I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man, I was shown mercy because I acted in ignorance and unbelief. The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus.”

“Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst.”

The Power of the Gospel to Save Sinners

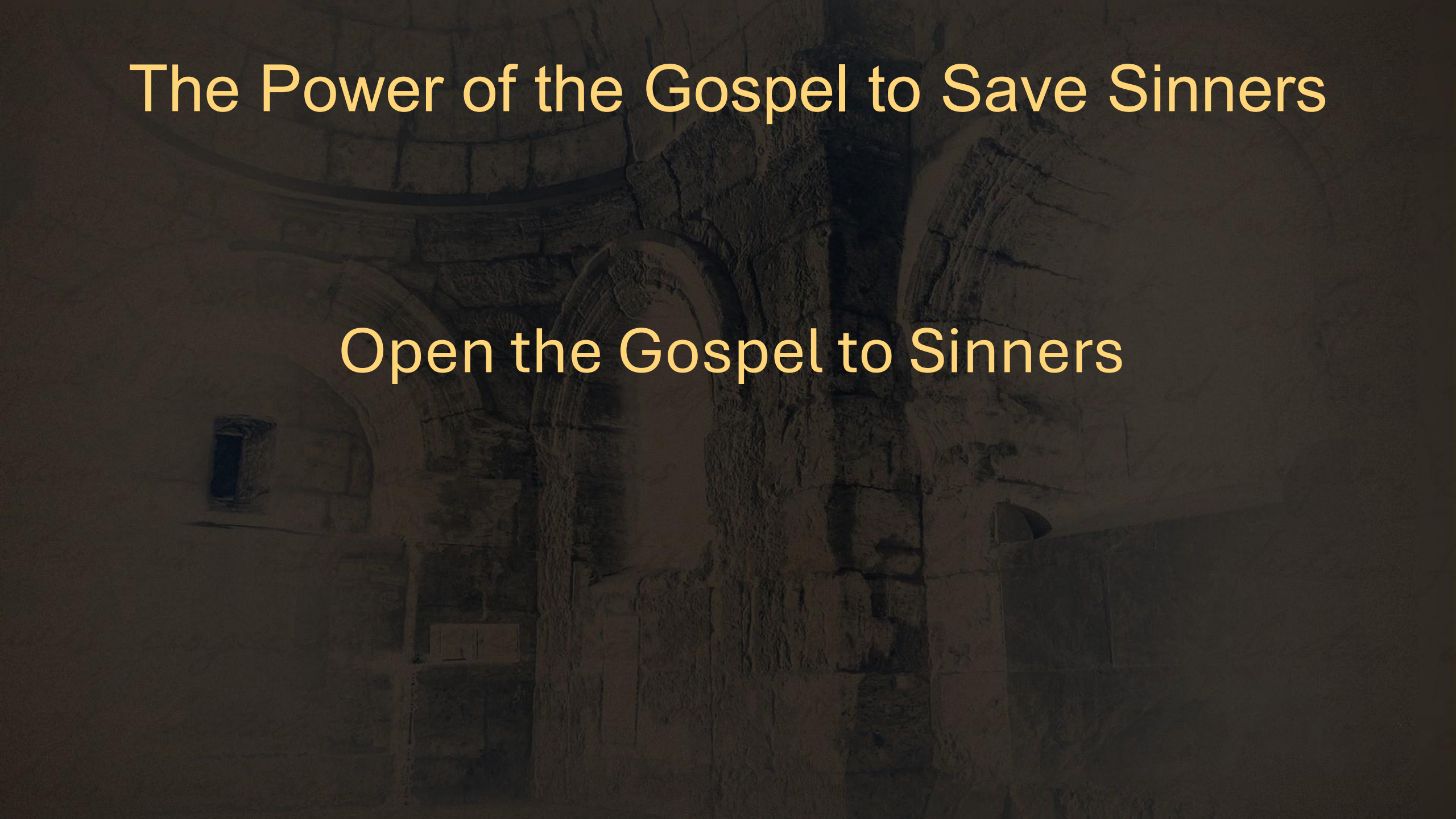
1 Tim 1:16

The Charge to Fight the Good Fight

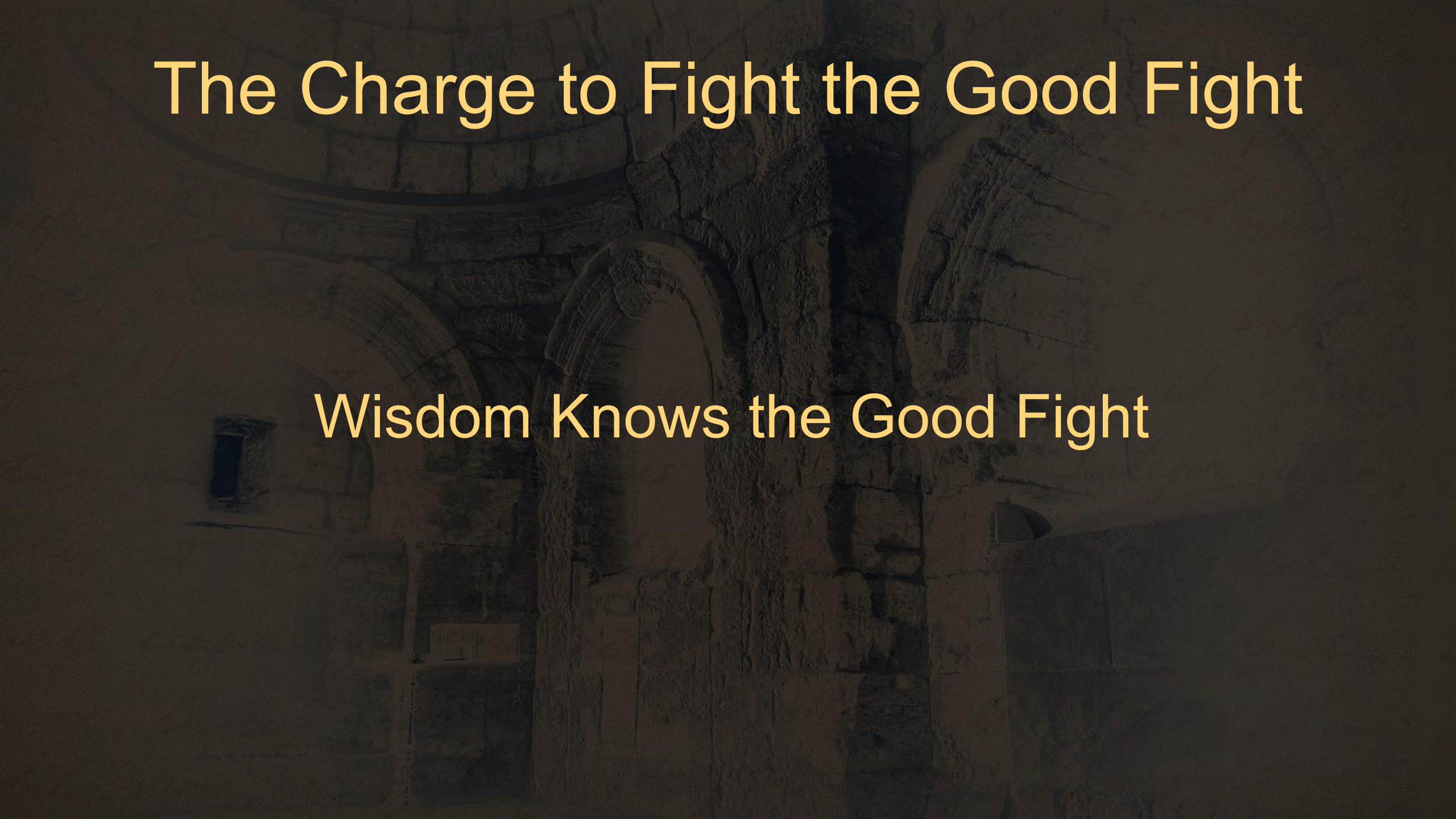
1 Tim 1:19

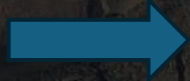

- What am I currently fighting for – would Jesus tell me it's worth fighting for?

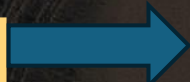

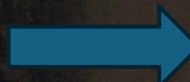

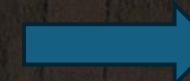
